





Arctic milestones

2006 GAC Hammerfest opens

Support of all LNG vessels calling Statoil Snowhite LNG terminal. GAC Norway became the leading offshore agency in Norway and UK in 2006-2011. Opening of Stavanger, Bergen Kristiansund, and Sandnessjoen. GAC Norway handles over 2500 shipping jobs and 12000 logistics jobs per year.

2009 GAC-PPS Spitsbergen opens

Agreement with local partner Pole Position Spitsbergen in Longyearbyen, Svalbard.

2010 GAC-HSS Kirkenes opens

Agreement with Henriksen Shipping Service (HSS). HSS have long experience with Russia and run a local supply base for the Russian crab fleet. HSS served the jack-up rig Energy Exerter and during 2012-2013 GAC-HSS support seismic and survey projects in Kara sea and Barents sea.

2012 Partnership with POLOG for Greenland.

POLOG specialists with background from the Sirius patrol on Greenland and services include basecamp construction and remote location logistics for the O&G and mining industry.

2012 Agency support 'Ob River'

The first LNG vessel to sail Northern Sea Route (NSR).

2012 GAC Murmansk opens

First tanker vessel served for Gazprom in Murmansk June 2012.

2013 'Solarctic' is established in Murmansk.

First tender submitted and first job executed.



GAC Arctic strategy

- Support of O&G exploration in the Arctic; East Barents sea exploration, Kara sea exploration, Pechora sea exploration, Yamal (Sabetta), O&G and transshipment terminals, NSR, Kirkenes, Honningsvaag, Vardoe, Hammerfest, Spitsbergen, Greenland
- **Integrated services** to the upstream industry with a particular focus on international survey and EPC companies. We go wherever our international customers go
- A regional **network** with the best local partners and customised services to the current O&G exploration stages. OOO Solarctic

- The O&G industry in North Russia is booming. In order to support international clients with solutions in the Russian Arctic the company *Solarctic* was established in Murmansk
- Solarctic was incorporated 2013 as a result of many years of collaboration between a shipping services company in Kirkenes, a Russian engineering company and GAC Norway. The company is 20% owned by Henriksen in Kirkenes, 20% owned by PGS in Murmansk and 60% owned by GAC Norway. Solarctic is also recognized by Innovation Norway.
- Solarctic specializes in services for the upstream industry and focus on existing international customers of GAC that are increasing their Arctic presence.
- Locally employed Russian staff in Murmansk with background in shipping and Arctic crew logistics.
- Operating since late 2013. Tender submitted for stevedoring services in Sabetta, first job executed in Murmansk and start of preparations for a number of offshore campaigns 2014-2015. Training of staff in Norway.


